## **Audit PSTN-Dependent Services**

Identify all services and systems that rely on PSTN/ISDN, including landlines, broadband (ADSL, FTTC), fax machines, emergency and lift alarms, telecare systems, card payment terminals, CCTV, entry/security systems, and building automation tools.



#### **Assess Internet Capacity**

Ensure your broadband is fibre-based and can support VoIP. If currently using ADSL or FTTC, upgrade to fibre (FTTP or SoGEA) for improved reliability and performance.



### **Choose a Digital Telephony Solution**

Evaluate options such as **VoIP**, **SIP** trunking, or **hosted** unified communications platforms.

Decide between a provider-managed or internally managed solution.



## Port Existing Numbers



Coordinate with your new provider to port existing numbers and schedule the migration to minimise downtime.



## **Replace or Adapt Hardware and Systems**



Upgrade or replace legacy handsets and devices. Ensure alarms, payment terminals, and emergency systems are compatible with digital networks..
